Afterschool High School Activities Volunteers-DASH

Come Volunteer with our ***DASH, Denfeld After School Happenings Program***. As a volunteer, you will support us in providing DASH (Denfeld After School Happenings), a safe space after school for high schoolers. DASH provides a safe space to study, access tutors, and participate in recreation.

DASH runs Monday- Thursday from 3:25 to 5:30 pm, all volunteers are supervised by the Denfeld Full-Service Community School Coordinator.

Description of things you will do at DASH

- Share a skill or talent with a group of students in a structured 1-hour class. This can be a one time class or multiple sessions for repeating or building skills.
- Support an activity or group with added supervision and engagement with teens.
- Help staff coordinate programming, actively engage students in relationship building with you and other staff, and facilitate
- Engage relationship building between volunteers and students.
- Having the ability to prioritize work, manage multiple tasks with efficiency, and being detail oriented is important.
- Work to engage high school aged youth, preferably with students of color and/or special needs, in a structured environment such as a youth center or classroom.

Volunteer commitments:

- Show up in-person for the students (ideally weekly)
- Follow program expectations
- Submit to a background check
- Personal commitment to anti-racism and the mission, goals, and philosophy of the Duluth Community School Collaborative
